– American Exchange Project

- New Program to Skyline
- Put together to give HS Seniors to do a Domestic Exchange Experience. To spend time in a different part of the Country that is totally different from the SLC East Bench
- Civil dialogue – the world is starting to fall apart. The Hope is our Young People.
- Process of Gathering HOST Families JUNE 24 – JULY 1. Host Families need to provide a Bed, transportation and maybe find a few places outside of The Agenda. There is a Stipend for the Host Families to cover food expenses.
- If she can get 10 Host Families then Skyline can send 10 kids out to the Country. Show the Kids all about UTAH, Why we Love it
- Kids would travel to another city and spend 1 week with kids from all over. Then Kids from all over come to Skyline to spend a week here in Salt Lake City. So it's a 2 Week Commitment.

PRINCIPAL REPORT – Rob

- Growth vs Coast Mindset. Easy to Coast with a High Performing School. I don't work that way. We're Great but where are we missing the Mark. What can we do better. PROGRESS
- Rob met individually with every Student who received awards and Thank them for the Positive things they do!!!
- IB is an Expensive Program. Helps kids even if they don't graduate from it. AP, Concurrent, CTE
- Really want an Awareness that Each Student is Unique and we want to Add to what we're doing to help provide opportunities for each of our Students
- B Building...All the teachers move out next week.
- Cardio room will become the Band Room
- Choir will move into the Testing Center Next Week
- Drama needs to communicate with the teachers
- Loose parking by the B Building but next week they will open up more parking
- Principal has started doing FOCUS Groups. This Thursday from 8am – 9am. PTA and CC are also like Focus Groups. Programs, Policies...what can we do to make this better for ALL Students here.
- Principal goes into classes with Sub's and he asks: Tell me what's working and what's not working. Doing this Every Single Day for about 1 Month.
- Intentionality – He's Switching up the Teacher Leadership team. Switch to 3 Coalitions of Leadership.

- Once group focused on the Braoder school picture, Efficiency of systems.
- 2nd group focused on Student ie where are we not performing. How can we celebrate success for students. School Culture. How we can improve the experience. What skills do these 9th grade kids need: Communication, Self Advocacy etc. What does a 10th grader need/ie a 10th grader should have these skills.
- 3rd Group – Staff. Personal Development. Happy Teachers lead to Happy Kids.
- Student Feedback – I don't like teachers who are always in a bad mood. I like teachers who care about me!!!
- Parents can excuse absences with an Email
- Starters can be made up or the teacher cannot use it against their grader. Starters are out of proficiency based. Currently a double jeopardy for being late. Getting a group to look at this and figure out a solution to the concern.
- Cell phones – teachers have good intentions but possibly bad policy around it
- Sarah – incentive for teachers to learn every name of their students & students to learn each others names
- Create a Student Coalition re Tardy and attendance policies
- Intervention – possibly everyday
